

	DOH's Adolescent and Young Adult Health launched a Mini Needs Assessment to learn
	more about the state of adolescent health from the perspectives of young people and
	their health care providers. The findings will help guide public health programs, inform
	public health policy, and ensure health care meets the needs of Washington's young
	people.
	We want to hear from medical and behavioral health providers working in Washington
	and serving teens and young adults. The topics we want to know more about include
	adolescent well-visits, behavioral health care, confidential care, youth-friendly care, and
	billing and reimbursement for adolescent health care. We have three ways youth-
	serving providers can share with us:
	Take an anonymous online survey: The survey has mostly open-ended questions and
	should take participants about 20 minutes to complete.
	• Participate in one of our virtual listing sessions on April 9 <sup>th</sup> , 2024. The first is



Each year, it is estimated that more than 2,000 youth and young adults in Washington experience a first episode of psychosis. The longer psychosis goes untreated, the more severe and chronic a person's symptoms may become.


